On Sunday May 4, 2014, at approximately 22:50, Cedar Park Police responded to the Lone Star Bank, located at 109 Cypress Creek Road, for a motion detection alarm. Upon arrival, the Officers observed smoke coming from the interior of the building. The Cedar Park Fire Department responded to the scene and determined that the fire was out. Subsequent investigation by the Cedar Park Fire Marshal's Office and Cedar Park Police Department revealed that the cause of the fire was arson. Surveillance footage obtained from the bank shows an unknown white male approach the bank on foot, break out a glass panel on the front of the bank, and enter the business. It also shows the individual pour what appears to be an unknown accelerant onto the carpet area, light it on fire, and then leave the bank on foot. An intense search of the area for the suspect yielded negative results. The Lone Star Bank suffered minimal damage as a result of the fire.

Suspect Description: White Male, possibly late teens to mid-20s, with a slender build. **Suspect Clothing Description:** Suspect wore a black beanie style hat, dark colored or black jacket, black tennis shoes, black t-shirt with a white emblem on front possibly a snake or dragon "S" pattern, and what appears to be a black mini-skirt.
