<u>UPDATE</u>* SEEKING SUSPECT IDENTITY * <u>UPDATE</u> - Possible Child Predator -

The Williamson County Sheriff's Office is investigating a suspicious incident that occurred on Saturday, September 5th, 2015 at approximately 6:00pm on the Rattan Creek Park Trail in North Austin Mud #1 just west of Parmer at Dallas Dr.


A 12 YOA female was on the walking trail at the bridge near where two paths intersect, west of Parmer and northeast of Rattan Park, when she was approached by an adult male.

The male subject engaged the juvenile in conversation and then reportedly grabbed the victim by the arm causing minor injury to the child.

The victim was able to get away from the alleged perpetrator when he noticed several others nearby on the trail and loosened his grip.

The subject then walked away from the trail heading north into a wooded





The subject was described as a Caucasian male, approximately 6'0, with a slim to medium build, short brown hair, and believed to be in his late 30s with unusually long fingernails. The male was wearing a white tank top, blue jeans, and had a large tattoo (possibly Old English text) on his left shoulder, extending down to his chest.
