HELPFUL GUIDELINES

- ATipster MUST contact Crime Stoppers first to be eligible for a reward of up to \$3000. Contacting a law enforcement agency and giving information to them disqualifies reward eligibility.
- A Tipster is provided a unique ID code to use to check the status of your tip and to claim your reward. DO NOT lose this code; it cannot be given to you again.
- The information provided by the Tipster must lead to an arrest to qualify for a reward.
- Check in frequently to determine the status of your Tip. Due to investigation procedures, an arrest related to the Tip may take a few weeks to months.
