### **What is cyberbullying?**

Cyberbullying is the use of electronic communication to bully a person, typically by sending messages of an intimidating or threatening nature.

### **Is cyberbullying against the law?**

Cyberbullying is **ILLEGAL** in Louisiana. Penalties can include up between \$500-\$5,000 in fines. Jail time of up to 6 months to 1 year.

### **What should I do if I am being cyberbullied?**

You should talk to a trusted adult as soon as possible. You can also report anonymously to the Crimestoppers Safe School App.

### **What is a bystander?**

If you see it happening online or in person that makes you a bystander. You can ask the bully to stop. You can tell a trusted adult. You can report anonymously to the Crimestoppers Safe School App. Please speak up! If you don't say anything. The bullying won't stop.

### **Is this cyberbullying?**

Ashley posted a picture of Jessica on Instagram 3 different times. In the comments, Ashley said how fat and ugly Jessica is.

YES, Jessica is being cyberbullied.
