



CBCS Law Scholarships
\$1,500.00 (\$750 per semester)

Bee County

Goliad County

Live Oak County

Criteria for eligibility:

1. Must be May graduate of a high school in Bee, Goliad and Live Oak counties.
2. One scholarship will be offered to a qualifying student in each of the three counties; however, if there is not a qualifying student in a county that scholarship can go to a qualifying student one of the other two counties.
3. The fourth scholarship is sponsored by the Bee County Sheriff's Office in memory of Sheriff Carlos Carrizales, Jr. and will go to a qualifying student in Bee County.
4. Completed application and resume submitted to Crime Stoppers by mail at 210 E. Corpus Christi St., Beeville, TX 78102 by specified dead line noted on the webpage. (coastalbendcrimestoppers.com)
5. **Must attend a junior/community college or 4-year college/university majoring in law enforcement/criminal justice or be the son/daughter/grandchild of a Texas commissioned peace officer.** (Majoring in any field)
6. G.P.A. enough to gain admittance to an institution listed in No. 5 above.
7. In need of financial assistance. Must explain need.

Procedures – Student:

1. Submit completed application with essay.
2. Submit current transcript showing class rank and GPA.
3. Typed essay shall include:
 - (1) a detailed description of services rendered at school and in community and
 - (2) explanation as to why applicant is applying for this scholarship and explain why they chose their field of study.
4. Submit application, essay, and transcript by specified time.

Procedures for award:

1. The Coastal Bend Crimes Stoppers directors shall make the final selection of the recipient of the scholarships.
2. In the event there are no qualifying applicants for the scholarships, the scholarships will not be given out. If there is no qualifying applicant for a county, it can go to a qualifying student in one of the other two counties. If there is not a qualifying applicant for the Bee County scholarship in memory of Sheriff Carlos Carrizales, Jr., that scholarship will not be awarded.

Payment of Scholarship:

1. One half of the scholarship will be awarded in the fall and one half will be awarded in the spring and paid directly to the college/university.
2. Student must show proof of enrollment (bill from registrar/schedule of classes/student ID number) and the address of the college/university office to whom the funds are sent.
