Criteria for eligibility:

- 1. Must be May graduate of a high school in Bee, Goliad and Live Oak counties.
- 2. One scholarship will be offered to a qualifying student in each of the three counties; however, if there is not a qualifying student in a county that scholarship will go to a qualifying student one of the other two counties.
- 3. The fourth scholarship is sponsored by the Bee County Sheriff's Office in memory of Sheriff Carlos Carrizales, Jr. and will go to a qualifying student in Bee County.
- Completed application and resume submitted to Crime Stoppers by mail at <u>210 E</u>. <u>Corpus Christi St., Beeville, TX 78102</u> by specified dead line noted on the webpage. (coastalbendcrimestoppers.com)
- 5. Must attend a junior/community college or 4-year college/university upon graduation majoring in law enforcement/criminal justice <u>or</u> be the son/daughter/grandchild of a Texas commissioned peace officer.
- 6. G.P.A. sufficient to gain admittance to an institution listed in No. 3 above.
- 7. In need of financial assistance. Must explain need.
- 8. To pursue a degree in the field of criminal justice.

Procedures – Student:

- 1. Submit completed, typed application with essay.
- 2. Submit current transcript showing class rank and GPA.
- 3. Submit completed, typed resume. Resumes shall include:
 - (1) a detailed description of services rendered at school and in community and
 - (2) explanation as to why applicant is applying for this scholarship.
- 4. Mail application, essay, transcript and resume by specified time.

Procedures for award:

- 1. The Coastal Bend Crimes Stoppers directors shall make the final selection of the recipient of the scholarships.
- 2. In the event there are no qualifying applicants for the scholarships, the scholarships will not be given out. If there is no qualifying applicant for a county, it will go to a qualifying student in one of the other two counties. If there is not a qualifying applicant for the Bee County SO's scholarship, that scholarship will not be given out.

Payment of Scholarship:

- 1. One half of the scholarship will be awarded in the fall and one half will be awarded in the spring.
- 2. Student must show proof of enrollment (bill from registrar and schedule of classes) prior to receiving each semester's payment.
