This year's event, "**Felines, Canines & Wines,**" will be held at Honolulu Country Club on Friday, April 6, 2018, from 5:30 to 10 p.m. Join advocates who are passionate about fighting crime and celebrate CrimeStoppers contributions in helping to solve 2,909 cases, which have led to 1,042 arrests, and recovered more than 5 million in stolen property as well as drugs out of our neighborhoods and schools. We are also focusing in on Animal CrimeStoppers which is gaining momentum in preventing animal cruelty, so your help is vital in protecting those that cannot protect themselves. The Crime Stoppers program has enjoyed great success with the anonymous information received which has led to the arrest and indictment of those responsible for committing felony offenses, boasting an average conviction rate of approximately 95% on cases solved by a tip to the program.
