



Crime Stoppers


The Crime Stoppers program began in 1977 from the efforts of local police departments and the Cuyahoga County Chiefs of Police Association. Our program now operates as an independent organization. The concept has developed into a combination of efforts by local media, businesses, civic and social clubs, law enforcement agencies and the public. Donations of airtime, newspaper space, and reward monies have established Crime Stoppers as an effective tool to fight crime in the area.

Why do we need Crime Stoppers?

Crime Stoppers is based on the principal that someone other than the criminal has information and can help solve a crime. Crime Stoppers was created to combat the three major problems faced by law enforcement in generating that information: fear of reprisal, an attitude of apathy and reluctance to get involved.

Crime Stoppers resolves these problems by offering anonymity to people who provide information and paying rewards when the information supplied leads to arrest.
